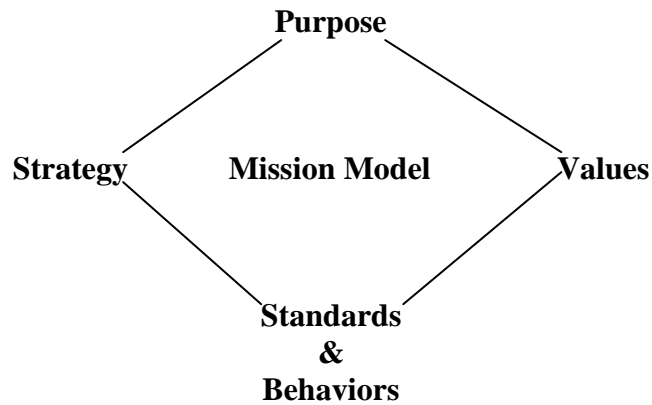

MISSION

Subject to the Church's resources, the other needs of the congregation such as welfare and human development/capacity building shall also receive the due attention of the Church. Purpose

- The name of the Church shall be **ALL NATIONS CHRISTIAN CHURCH.**

Strategy

- Openness and godly love for all men, women and children of all races.
- Diligence and sincerity of purpose in the service of the Lord.
- We may sing songs and choruses in African languages for praise and worship, but songs and choruses in English language shall have higher preference. Songs and choruses in African languages shall be discouraged if English translations are not projected on the screen for the benefit of others who may not understand the African languages.
- Provision of effective and transparent spiritual leadership in all areas of administration and ministration.

- Provision of welfare needs, and needs of human development/capacity building,i.e free food pantry, seminars/workshops on property acquisition, Believers' partnerships, entrepreneurial skills, insurance, legal advice, job interviews, human networking, government grants/aid programs, scholarship schemes, computer literacy and typewriting skills, family health matters, financial planning,etc.
- Environmental excellence and cleanliness at all places of worship.
- Spirit-filled mass-choir, for excellent performance at all places and times of worship.
- Implementation of effective evangelism programs, backed by training from experts.
- Effective follow-up of Guests and New Converts
- Encouragement of regular training for Ministers and Workers.
- Prayers at all times for all things, but particularly for miracles in the lives of believers.
- Development of a vibrant youth & children ministry.

Standards and Behaviors

- Attainment of the highest standards of excellence in the handling of all Church assignments.

- All Workers must be water-baptised.
- Baptism must be by immersion (not by sprinkling).
- Ministers and Workers to demonstrate diligent service, good prayer life and good understanding of the scriptures.

- Ministers and Workers will strive to be holy, and be seen to be men and women of integrity; otherwise the basis for leadership will not exist.
- Ministers must be blameless.
- Both planning and prayers are requisites for all major Church programs or events
- Respect for all members of the Church, as all mankind are created equal before God.
- The name of our Lord Jesus Christ shall be lifted up at all times
- Leadership at all levels shall be exemplary
- Leadership will show humility in service, in the wisdom and fear of God.
- No compromise of values and integrity for any reason whatsoever; - not even for the purpose of growing the congregation.
